Instructions for Presentations

- 1) Create a **voice over Power Point** of your project and note the following requirements:
 - a) Voice over Power Point must be **limited to 6 minutes**
 - b) The presentation should consist of slides that describe your research:
 - overview, materials, methods, findings, conclusions (does not have to be presented in this order, but you should cover these topics so that judges can understand your project)
 - there is not a limit on the number of slides used, but be mindful that you are limited to a 6 minute presentation
- 2) Rehearse and convey what you want your audience to know when you are done
 - a) Aims of the project and why it is important
 - b) Research Methodology
 - c) Clear results and impact of the project
 - d) Anticipate questions that Judges may have as they will not be able to ask and hear your responses

Virtual Scoring Information

- SEMCME will assign and notify your 2 judges to score the voice over PowerPoint between **May 27 through June 3rd 2020**.
- Judges will log into their online account to score each presentation and will have the ability to send written feedback to the presenter. The QI Summit organizers will send all written feedback to presenters after conclusion of the judging period.
- All judge scores will be converted to standard scores (Z scores) to account for variation in how judges Score. The scores will determine the competition winners for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for resident presentations and 1st place for fellow presentations.
- QI Summit organizers will notify winners and will make arrangements to deliver awards to their recipients.
